The Proposal - To make The Hill a no through road.

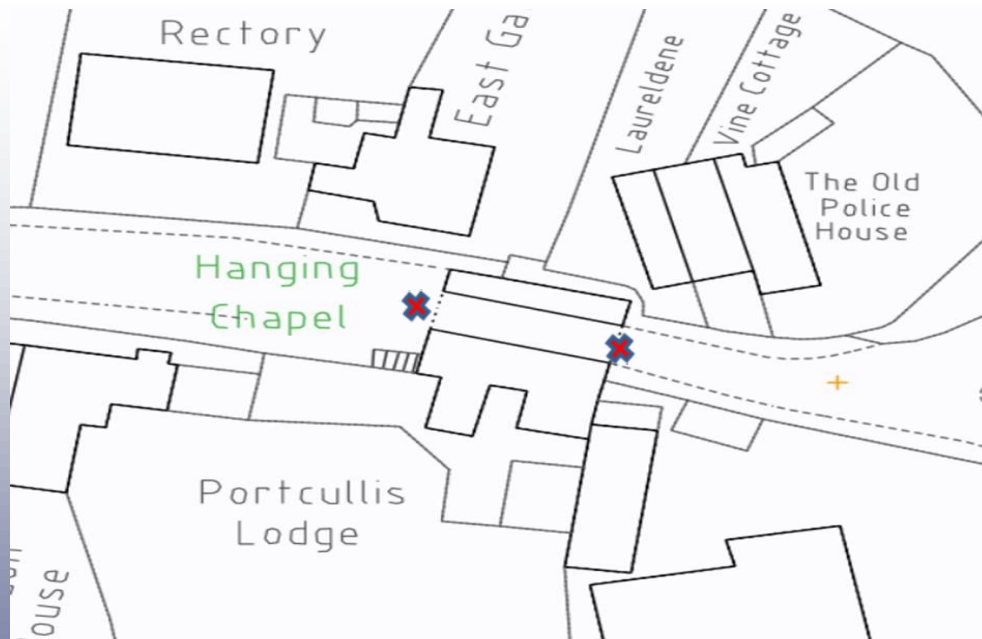
How - Installation of bollards on either side of the Hanging Chapel. (Appendix 1)

Why - **'Protection'** The Hanging Chapel and Medieval Gateway is a Grade 1 Listed Building and a Scheduled Monument under the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979. Throughout the years it has been damaged by lorries with two incidents causing significant damage in the last two months.

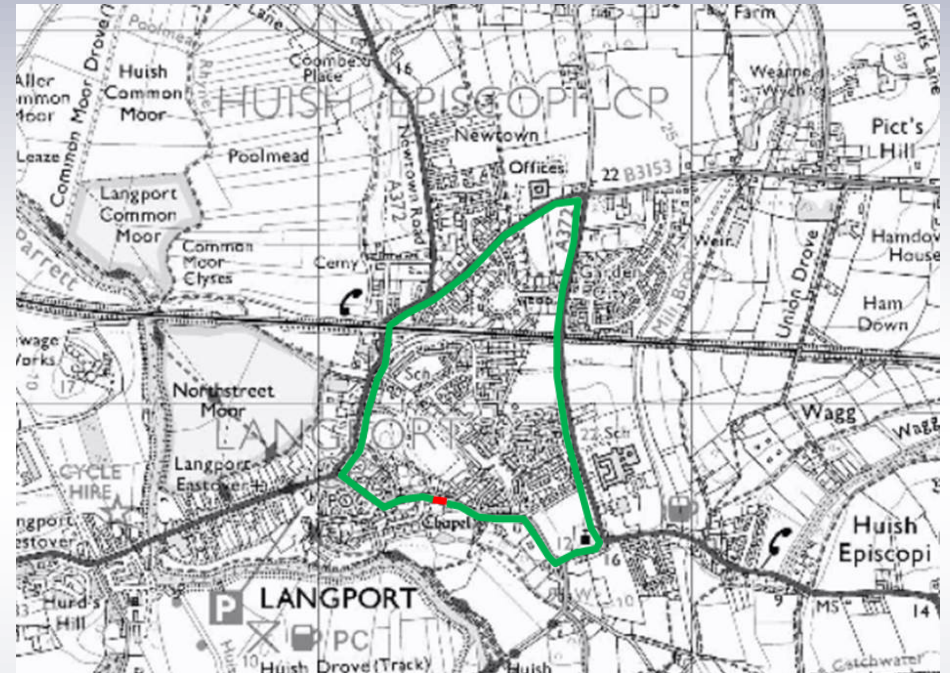
'Safety' The road is narrow and steep in places, which has resulted in parked cars being damaged by passing vehicles.

Impact of the proposal - Traffic will no longer be able to pass under The Hanging Chapel but will be able to use the A372. (Appendix 2)
